NOT ACCEPTED	In addition to specific items listed above, the following are NOT accepted:  Cement Candles Clothing Plate glass Wooden items Packing peanuts Light bulbs (any type) VHS, cassette tapes, CDs, and DVDs Clam shells and similar food packaging Paints, stains, sealers, and other hazardous materials Rigid plastics (buckets, flower pots, lawn furniture, storage totes, etc.) Flexible plastics not listed (chip bags, frozen food bags, candy bar wrappers, net or mesh produce bags, crinkly films like floral wrap, and pet food bags)
