(2) <u>NOT</u> accepted: Insulation or soft foam</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">Art Supplies ReMix It AVL</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Basic craft tools ● Keys and zippers ● Binders and folders ● Stickers and stencils ● Beads, buttons, sequins, and ribbon ● Tape and glue (including Mod Podge) ● Rulers, scissors, staplers, and hole punches ● Sewing, crochet, knitting, and embroidery supplies ● Paint (acrylic, gouache, and watercolor) and brushes ● Clean felt, textiles, and fabric (min. fat quarter; ~18x22") ● Paper products (folders, sketchbooks, and drawing pads) ● Writing utensils (pens, pencils, markers, crayons, and colored pencils), erasers, and pencil sharpeners
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>NOT ACCEPTED</u></p>	<p>In addition to specific items listed above, the following are <u>NOT</u> accepted:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Cement ● Candles ● Clothing ● Plate glass ● Wooden items ● Packing peanuts ● Light bulbs (any type) ● VHS, cassette tapes, CDs, and DVDs ● Clam shells and similar food packaging ● Paints, stains, sealers, and other hazardous materials ● Rigid plastics (buckets, flower pots, lawn furniture, storage totes, etc.) ● Flexible plastics <u>not</u> listed (chip bags, frozen food bags, candy bar wrappers, net or mesh produce bags, crinkly films like floral wrap, and pet food bags)
